- Ability to collaborate with other design professionals when participating in internal or external design charrettes

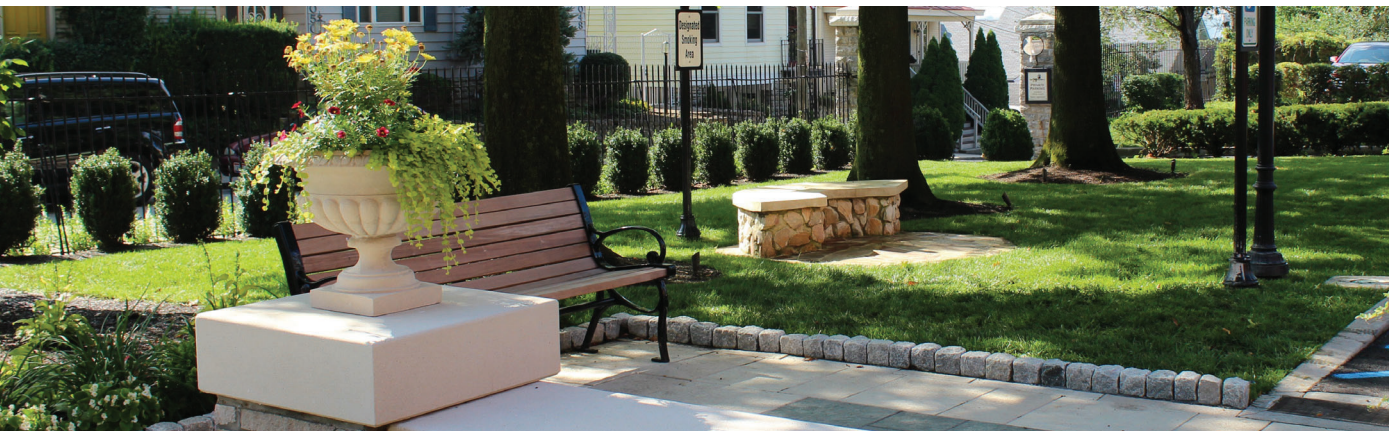
Position Responsibilities
