Bayer Becker collaborated with the City of Springboro to create a primary gateway for the community at the intersection of SR 741 & SR 73. The reconstruction of the intersection inspired the City to consider a new gateway into the community at this highly visible location. The project incorporated a new sign with a digital display screen, entry plaza with a location for public art, lighting for the new gateway, and a new pergola. The space is envisioned to host small gatherings and serve as the inspiration for a new entry into Wright Station development to the West. New Pavers articulate the plaza that is embraced by lush plantings to provide visual and physical separation from surrounding uses.
